PrintMaster 18 and the Print Shop 23 and earlier can't convert to PDF with embedded fonts. PDFs with embedded fonts have a smaller file size and the text prints sharp and looks sharp no matter how much you zoom in. I can help with tips and techniques to make a PDF with embedded fonts.
