We currently have 86 members. Club nights have not been very busy, so we hope to see everyone out. If you do not have email their will be newsletters and calendars in the equipment box.

Enclosed with this newsletter is a calendar with scheduled nights of play and special events. Please keep this handy and check it closely. We are at the mercy of the school for our gym time. If we have a last minute cancellation, your executive will try to notify you by email, or phone, if possible. Check our website often for updates and cancellations. Adult gym time is Monday & Wednesday only. Fridays is exclusively for the Junior Club.

Guests are welcome to our club for a \$5.00 fee per night. **The maximum times a guest may come out without joining is five (5) within one season.** There is a sign-up book in the equipment box. Please have your guest sign the book, and pay the fee to an executive member. We will then write up a name tag for them to use for the night. If they decide to join, any paid guest fees would be deducted from their membership fee.

BADMINTON ETIQUETTE

Please respect our facility. There is no smoking on school property. No food or drink is allowed in the gym. Any damage by a club member is the club's responsibility. Do not play with any school equipment. Our contract is for the use of the school gym and change rooms, by adults only, and the 10 student members accepted. Please leave children at home. Please help to set up and take down the nets each evening so the same people are not doing it all. The combination to the equipment box is **XXXXXX**. Poles are stacked behind the door in the equipment room. Birds are put away in their tubes. When setting up nets, use a simple "s" hook. Do not tie knots. The courts should be cleared by 9:50 PM and the last ones off must put the birds, name board and nets away in the equipment box. Lock the equipment box and put it in the equipment room along with the poles. A big must is the bleachers have to be pushed back as it takes more than one person and the janitor cannot do this alone. **Also Aa big must is to please make sure gym doors to the outside are closed properly.** Proper gym attire is to be worn which includes non-marking sole running shoes and the absence of ball caps.

MONSIGNOR DOYLE HIGH SCHOOL

We have attempted to fill cancelled nights at St. Benedict's with nights at Monsignor Doyle High School on Myers Road. There will be a map on the website if you need directions. There are only 6 courts but your executive will try to plan special nights, such as Black Knight to Remember, coaching, round robins etc. so we do not need to use our board system.

BOARD SYSTEM

Members are coded as follows: Red – advanced, Blue - Advanced Intermediate, Green - intermediate, Black – Beginner and Gold – New Member

New members are encouraged to obtain a color as soon as possible by arranging a challenge match. You can do this by talking with an executive member. There are many former members that are not color coded to their ability. To make this board system work, we need the co-operation from all members by challenging for their proper color. The executive will be approaching several members to challenge in the very near future.

On club nights, new members are encouraged to ask for assistance when picking a game. Players' coded black may pick from black & green. Greens may pick from black, green and blue. Blues and reds may pick from anyone. All picks must be from the **top ten** names on the board. If you must pick outside your color group please, check with that member first.

WE DO NOT HAVE AN OFFICIAL BOARD CAPTAIN THIS YEAR. YOUR EXECUTIVE IS ASKING ALL CLUB MEMBERS TO GIVE A HAND AT ARRANGING GAMES AND KEEPING THE BOARD FLOWING. IF GAMES ARE PICKED IN ADVANCE FROM THE TOP 10 MEMBERS ON THE LIST, COURTS WILL BE FILLED FASTER AND YOU WILL GET TO PLAY MORE GAMES.

HOUSELEAGUE

Teams will be made up in the next couple of weeks. Houseleague is based on first come basis. Therefore anyone that does not make a team will receive a refund. Teams will play every 2nd or 3rd Wed. and the commitment is for the **entire** season. House League uses 3 courts on Wed. nights and open badminton is available on the remaining 5 courts. If you signed up for House League you **MUST** show up or notify your captain in advance so a spare can be arranged as soon as possible. Once the teams are made up and a schedule completed, your team captain will notify you. If you miss two or more games without a good explanation, we will replace you with another member for the remainder of the year. **GAMES WILL BE DEFAULTED IF YOU ARE NOT ON THE COURT AND READY TO PLAY BY 7:15 PM. GAMES WILL BE PLAYED IN THE ORDER OF THE FORMAT. DON'T LET YOUR TEAM DOWN.**
